## Connect-a-Book

Setting: Any size room with a table
Size: Any number of children

Provide:
Leader Help Item 3

- Scissors
$\square$ Felt (2 colors)
Laminating film or clear adhesive plastic $\square$ Glue
- Cardboard or poster board


## Instructions:

I. Children will take turns putting their game markers on an intersecting point between four books.
2. Children may begin at any point on the gameboard, but must complete a task in order to leave their marker there.
3. Tasks may include:
I. Pronounce all four books.
2. Name the book that follows each book the marker touches.
3. Find all four books in the Bible.
4. Blank squares are free spaces.
5. The player who has four markers in a row (players may try to block each other) is the winner.
6. The game may be played individually or in teams.

To Do:
P Print Leader Help Item 3 and mount on cardboard, with the Old Testament on one side and the New Testament on the other.
Laminate or cover with clear plastic.
Cut out 40 round, nickel-sized game markers from 2 colors of paper or felt (20 of each color).

Teaching Points: Children will learn the books of the Bible.
