

Trusting God Footprints

- Distribute copies of "Foot Pattern." Guide each child to trace around a foot pattern on two sheets of craft foam and eight pieces of white paper. Cut out the shapes.
- Instruct kids to each write a title such as *Trusting God* or *I Can Trust God* on one piece of craft foam.
- Stack the white sheets between the two covers and punch a hole in the "heel" of the stack. Direct each child to insert a brad through the hole.
- Share the Bible story "Ruth's Family" (Ruth 1-2; 4:13-17).
- Tell kids they can write prayers or prayer requests in their booklets. Encourage kids to use their booklets often to remind them to trust God in all situations.

- Complete the craft as written, reminding kids that God gave the Israelites dry land on which to walk.
- The Church Sent Relief (Acts 11:19-30)
- Complete the craft as written, reminding kids that God expects the church to help people in need.
- Paul's First Journey (Acts 13:1-15:35)
- Complete the craft as written, reminding kids that when Paul was a missionary, he had to walk or ride in boats to each location.
