## <sub>Sweeper</sub> Relay

- , Form several teams of kids. Give each team a paper bat and a ball.
- Give each to the start and turn around lines. Explain that players will point to the start line to the turn around

line and back.

- Announce that the first team to complete the relay is the winner. Announce Announce Signal kids to start the relay. Encourage players as they complete the relay. Urge players to cheer for their teammates.
